Hobuveski, in the end of the Lai St, near Oleviste Church and the town wall is itself a round cellerd two storied limestone building with a 16 meters diameter. First mentioned in 1379, initially used to make flour with 8 horses walking in pairs to do the work. By now, is has not been used to make flour for about 200 years.
